



# Atlantic City Holds First Flag Retirement Ceremony




The City of Atlantic City teamed up with the American legion to hold the city's first Flag Retirement Ceremony at Bader Field on Wednesday, June 14th

(Flag Day).




The ACPD will continue collecting old U.S. flags at the Public Safety Building.
